

To all School and Staff members associated with the _____ School District (# _____) (the “District”) for school year 20__-20__;

This notice (the “Notice”), dated _____, 20__, is being sent to inform the Principal(s), teachers, and any and all District faculty and staff for whom my child, _____, has exposure to while upon any District property or in attendance at any District activity or function of our expectation that all state and federal laws will be adhered to, and especially the following:

Title 20 - 1232h. Protection of pupil rights

No student shall be required, as part of any applicable program, to submit to a survey, analysis, or evaluation that reveals information concerning— (1) political affiliations or beliefs of the student or the student’s parent; (2) mental or psychological problems of the student or the student’s family; (3) sex behavior or attitudes; (4) illegal, anti-social, self-incriminating, or demeaning behavior; (5) critical appraisals of other individuals with whom respondents have close family relationships; (6) legally recognized privileged or analogous relationships, such as those of lawyers, physicians, and ministers; (7) religious practices, affiliations, or beliefs of the student or student’s parent; or (8) income (other than that required by law to determine eligibility for participation in a program or for receiving financial assistance under such program), without the prior consent of the student (if the student is an adult or emancipated minor), or in the case of an unemancipated minor, without the prior written consent of the parent. [Emphasis added]

Pursuant to this statute, we hereby demand that prior to any discussions, topics, presentations, assignments or any other forms of instruction or communication (collectively, “Presentations”), with my child with regard to the below listed matters (collectively, “Sensitive Topics”), you obtain from us a **formal, written, signed consent** (a “Consent”). Furthermore, we demand sufficient time to review the Presentations prior to giving Consent.

- CSE (Comprehensive Sexual Education) including Gender Dysphoria, pronoun usage, sexual orientation, rainbow flags/stickers/posters, abortion, and any other sexually based related items that have exploration outside what constitutes a biological male or female
- CRT (Critical Racism Teaching/Training) Color of one’s skin and race-related topics (outside of the one human Race) including privilege, oppression, oppressor/oppressed, and whiteness
- DEI (Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion) including Culturally & Linguistically Responsive Teaching
- Un-established historical documentation (standards-based instruction written post 1990) or “perspectives-based” instructional standards
- SEL (Social Emotional Learning – Teaching the “Whole Child”) related items including but not limited to: Self Awareness, Self-Management, Responsible Decision Making, Relationship Skills, and Social Awareness
- Climate Change belief system based on non-objective environmental crisis (Outside Natural Earth Cycles)

We hereby further notify you that, in the absence of a Consent, our child has our permission to dismiss himself/herself from any and all Presentations pertaining to Sensitive Topics. In this event that we were not given the opportunity to give prior permission of the items listed above, an evaluation of such event shall take place with the parent(s)/guardian(s) and the District staff and supervisors involved. As you are aware, merely providing parent access to the applicable curricular materials does not constitute an explicit prior parent permission. As Title 20 states, this is an opt-in process, not an opt-out process.

The failure to adhere to Title 20 requirements and to this Notice constitute a breach of conduct on your part and could subject the District to legal action.
